EYMARD FEST - JULY 12 -13, 2014

For as long as Saint Paschal Baylon has been a parish the Congregation of the Blessed Sacrament has administered it. Saint Peter Julian Eymard founded the Congregation of the Blessed Sacrament in 1856. Father Eymard had a profound love for the Eucharist. In fact, the Eucharist was most certainly the great love of his life. Moreover, he desired to share that love with the entire Church. He founded the Congregation of the Blessed Sacrament to do just that, to make known God's tremendous gift of love in the Eucharist.

Since its founding many years ago The Congregation of the Blessed Sacrament has taken this mission to heart. "Our ideal" as our Rule of Life states, "is to live the mystery of the Eucharist fully and to make known its meaning, so that Christ's reign may come and the glory of God be revealed." Through our Center for Eucharistic Evangelizing, publications like *Emmanuel* magazine and through our many parish ministries we attempt to realize Father Eymard's unique vision for the Church.

This August 1st through the 3rd, we will be celebrating the life and work of Saint Peter Julian Eymard. We are happy to welcome Father Anthony Schueller, SSS and Father William Fickel, SSS who will both be preaching at our weekend masses. Their lifelong commitment to promoting the Eucharist will provide much food for thought and reflection. Additionally, we are blessed to have Father Norman Pelletier, SSS who will give a presentation on Saint Peter Julian Eymard. Besides being the provincial superior of the Congregation of the Blessed Sacrament (Province of Saint Ann) and being former General Superior of the Congregation worldwide, Father Pelletier is an Eymardian scholar whose book *Tomorrow Will Be Too Late: A Life of Saint Peter Julian Eymard* is the quintessential introduction to the life of Saint Peter Julian Eymard. 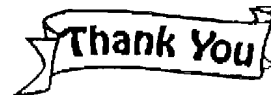

To avoid a late fee, **please register BEFORE AUGUST 1.** Early tuition rates for this year are \$85 for 1 child, \$155 for 2 children, and \$230 for 3 or more children. **Scholarships are available.** Additionally, our registration form this year also serves as the emergency medical form as well as the media release form for your convenience.

Special note: Two years of sacramental preparation is required. If you have a child entering 1st grade or 7th grade and are interested in them receiving their sacraments in 2nd and 8th grades the following year, please make sure to enroll them in PSR for this coming school year.
