FROM THE PASTOR'S PERSPECTIVE



Week 27 in Ordinary Time Begins: “Keep on doing what you have learned and received and heard and seen in me.” This quote from Saint Paul’s letter to the Philippians is a nice way to begin remembering why we as Catholic Christians celebrate Respect Life month in October every year. We learn early on the importance of being a precious child of God and that everyone is sacred, from womb until our natural death. Yet, we live in a secular culture, that opposes many of our Christian values and treats humans as product and profit. As Cardinal Basil Hume has written in *The Mystery of Love*, “There are two words which I believe are the very soul of [God’s] peace [and respecting human life]. These words are love and life. Neglect love, neglect life, then you cannot have peace. They find their prototype and the highest expression in God himself. God is love; God is life. That is the ultimate explanation as to why these two are so precious and must be respected.”

Continuing, Cardinal Hume states: “Wouldn’t it be good if we lived in a society in which love was respected and honored, and in which life was respected and protected? If we really were concerned for each other, and the needs of the other were more important; if we all thought and acted like that, we would have peace.” As we continue to use weapons of destruction against fellow human beings, weapons against the womb and those with different extreme beliefs, let us continue to be living the Beatitudes: Blessed are the peacemakers; they are the children of God.

More parishioners and non-parishioners are joining in this round the clock ministry. Here are a few reminders at the end of the day:

- Please repose the Blessed Sacrament to the tabernacle, removing the luna from the monstrance and bowing before retrieving. After placing in the tabernacle, show reverence to the Blessed Sacrament. Shut the tabernacle doors and remove the key.
- Take the key, monstrance and place in the sacristy safe.
- The key goes on a special hook on the safe door.
- Blow out the candles and turn off the chapel lights

If you are unfamiliar with where items are kept, please see Deacon Joe or one of the priests and they will assist you. If no one shows up for the shift following yours, please follow these same procedures above for the protection of the Blessed Sacrament. If another person comes later in the day, please turn on the lights and light the candles. Even if we are not following the liturgical rite of exposition, the Real Presence of Christ is present and our prayer witness continues as we stay with the Lord in the chapel, present in the tabernacle.
