There are restrictions in what parishes can do and allow in terms of: voter guides and campaign literature, renting facilities to candidates, allowing flyers to be placed on cars in parish parking lots, and allowing political sign to be placed on parish property, among other activities. 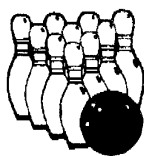
A VERY SPECIAL DAY
