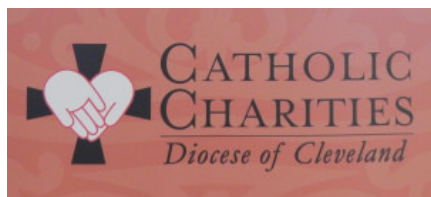

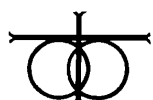

A NOTE ABOUT CONFIRMATION

We are blessed to take on Saint Paschal Baylon's 8th grade Confirmation program this year. This sacrament requires prayer, discussion, and service. The journey of our Confirmation candidates began with our parent meeting in September. Since then, our 7 Confirmation catechists prepare monthly lessons that will include interviews and our Confirmation retreat. Confirmation this year is April 26 with Bishop Gries.

Confirmation is the sacrament that completes the grace we receive in Baptism. It seals, or confirms, this grace through the 7 Gifts of the Holy Spirit that we receive as part of Confirmation. This sacrament also makes us better able to participate in the worship and apostolic life of the Church. Like baptism, Confirmation is received only once in a person's life.

A good way to understand the Sacrament of Confirmation is to take a closer look at the word *Confirm*. "To confirm" is to acknowledge or verify a previous action which is going to lead to a future action. For example, when you buy something online, you receive an email that confirms your purchase, which you will later receive. The email confirms, verifies, and completes something that took place earlier and points to something that will follow.

In the same way, the Sacrament of Confirmation can only be understood in relation to a previous action and an action that will follow. In this case, the previous action is the celebration of the Sacrament of Baptism and the action to follow will be the reception of the Eucharist and full initiation to and participation in the Church. Confirmation completes the sacraments of initiation and marks the entrance of an individual into the adult Christian community. Through Baptism, Confirmation, and the Eucharist, one becomes a full member of the Church.

Our Confirmation candidates will have learned about all aspects of the sacrament including images of the Holy Spirit, Corporal and Spiritual Works of Mercy, Theological Virtues, Cardinal Virtues, the Gifts of the Holy Spirit, the Fruits of the Holy Spirit, Pentecost, and the Confirmation Mass itself. They are currently in the process of selecting their Confirmation sponsors and choosing their Confirmation names.

In addition to the monthly Confirmation sessions, our candidates are asked to complete 20 hours of service. At Baptism, we received the grace that enables us to love and serve others without counting the cost and to see Christ in others. Grace makes us eager to reach out to others. It leads us to use our gifts and talents to meet others' needs. Confirmation strengthens the love within us. We show we have loving hearts when we perform works of Mercy. We've asked our Candidates to think about the following in regards to service: Your attitude toward service can teach people how to have a heart for others. Is your attitude toward service positive? Do you look for ways to serve others? Do you consider it a privilege to serve? Followers of Jesus who believe that he loves them will show the same love to others. When we reach out to others in service with the joy and strength of the Holy Spirit, we find we are the ones who really receive. We receive Christ, who lives in the people we serve.

Not only are our Confirmation candidates asked to complete service hours, we've also asked that they attend several Youth Group meetings throughout the course of the year. Mrs. Mickol, our Youth Group minister, has worked diligently to create a meaningful and spiritual calendar for our Youth Group. The meetings she plans are thought-provoking and fun. They promote a prayerful, deeper

relationship with God as well as an atmosphere of fellowship with peers. These meetings will aid in our candidates' preparation for Confirmation.

As the Catechism of the Catholic Church states, "Preparation for Confirmation should aim at leading the Christian toward a more intimate union with Christ and a more lively familiarity with the Holy Spirit – his actions, his gifts, his biddings – in order to be more capable of assuming the apostolic responsibilities of Christian life. To this end, catechesis for Confirmation should strive to awaken a sense of belonging to the Church of Jesus Christ, the universal Church, as well as the parish community." The preparation of our Confirmation candidates -- including our Confirmation sessions, service hours, and Youth Group meetings -- aim to do just that: involve our 8th graders in the community, the parish, the Church, and a deeper relationship with the Holy Spirit.
