

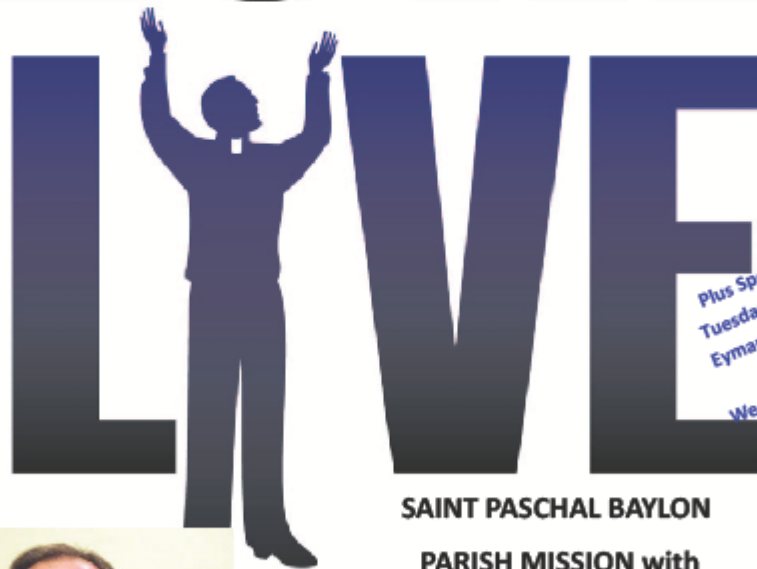

5TH WEEK OF ORDINARY TIME: The service that the mother-in-law of Peter gave when Christ healed her is always a wonderful testimony to me. It reminds me of the great service of so many here in our parish! As we prepared the Pastoral Plan, it was edifying to hear from the parishioners how important it is to be of service and that our parish continue and strengthen its great outreach. With new members on our Helping Hands Board and Manna

Ministries, we see our outreach to our parishioners in need and those in northeastern Ohio always on many of our parishioners' minds. We too are acting as Christ – healing and helping, serving, because this is what we Christians do!

CONTINUED GENEROSITY AND STEWARDSHIP: We received our quarterly check from the diocesan capital campaign – and it is more than usual! Thanks for continuing to make your payment on your pledge – and even those who did not initially pledge but have contributed recently: THANK YOU! GUEST COLUMN MAINTENANCE SUPERVISOR ROGER FISHER

The best maintenance job is the one no one notices. In October, the maintenance staff took on a major lighting update.

The lights in the planter boxes and the outer ring above the windows were updated to LED bulbs. The planter box lights were replaced from 3,000 watts of power to 340 watts of power. The outer ring was decreased from 10,000 watts of power to 600 watts of power. This is a cost savings of \$1.61 per hour to 11 cents per hour.

The maintenance staff will continue to work on energy cost efficient measures.

On Saturdays I change the vigil lights, clean the toilets and vacuum the church. About 4 or 5 times during the weekdays I visit a place called Haven of Hope, a compound of about 10 buildings for the needy and homeless. I do counseling at Haven of Hope and was offered a paid position last year.

The Clown and Helping Hands Ministry of Saint Paschal Parish continue to grow and reach out because of the generosity of this parish. It does not depend on one person but a large group of loving and devoted volunteers.
