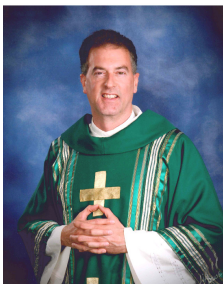

**Maintenance Improvements This Summer.** As the saying goes as we see so many orange barrels around town, “it’s our tax dollars at work.” So it goes with our parish each summer, when we do the majority of our major maintenance projects. You have seen that we have had the majority of our pot holes filled – those that could be. Some are not able to maintain fill do to the condition below the surface – but that’s an issue for a capital campaign to replace our drives and parking lots – another discussion at some point in the near future! However for the immediate future, we plan on replacing the concrete around the SE Narthex (the handicap door) with a heated pad and wider entrance to assist the many who use this entrance/exit into church. We know you have appreciate the special door; now we want to fix the cracks and the icing situations that happen each winter.

Other projects are in the works for this summer as we continuously improve our property. Yes, it’s sad we are not able to plant flowers anymore; as in your yard, everything is eaten by the deer. Another major project is removing the modular building that was put in in 1988 – it’s past it’s prime and no longer able to function as an art and science building. This building will be removed and light landscaping and another exit door added. In a few short weeks we will be able to share with you the plan to replace these rooms of the school; “several ducks are still getting into a row.”

**Orientation for 8<sup>th</sup> Grade – PSR and Day School:** One of the suggestions I have received and is part of the Pastoral Plan – to share the wonderful catechesis about the sacraments sooner than later for our students and parents. As you have noticed in the “Save the Date” section of the bulletin, we have taken the suggestion seriously and our Pastoral Staff will be meeting with our parents and students to give an overview for the year to come. We look forward to seeing them all this Wednesday night in the Eymard Room. It’s an exciting year of growth and maturity – and we look forward to celebrating and working together all year.
