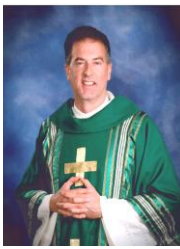

Solemnity of Saint Ann: This weekend we are blessed as a parish to celebrate the solemnity of Saint Ann, the patron of our province (USA) of the Congregation of the Blessed Sacrament (SSS). Our patron saint for the province was chosen for us, the SSS, when we inherited a parish in New York City (the famous parish of Saint Jean Baptiste at 76th & Lexington) when the SSS began administering this parish in 1900. It was a French-Canadian-American parish, which is why we were given custody of it. The parish had already had a strong devotion to Saint Ann for many years due to the relic of Saint Ann, the one that is currently in Quebec at the famous shrine, having “visited” the parish for a few years before that Canada shrine was complete. Due to the miraculous healings that occurred, the parishioners requested their very own relic for a shrine in NYC, which they received. When our order added an additional shrine, here at Saint Paschal Baylon (in the SSS building and our chapel on Wilson Mills), we began to also have this special Triduum in honor of Good Saint Ann, the grandmother of Jesus.

The readings for this Sunday remind us of the healing power of Christ. Saint Ann, like any wonderful grandmother, always taught her daughter and grandson the power of God’s healing love. The home in Jerusalem, attributed to Saint Ann, is near the healing waters of an old gate of the city. Saint Ann trusted in God’s healing powers and witnessed them in this wonderful experience. Today, we bring this same healing power to all through the miracle of prayer and the sacrament of the anointing of the sick. We pray through the intercession of Saint Ann that we continue to be healers and witnesses to the great healer, Jesus Christ, who gives us the power of prayer and the sacraments to minister to so many in need, especially those who minister through the Mass and go to share the Eucharist with those unable to be physically present. This special ritual reminds all of us that our brothers and sisters are never far from the altar of God, the altar and home of healing!

Construction in Progress: Each summer we do our major projects to get the campus ready for a new school year and take advantage of the great weather. As we all know, it has been a rainy summer, and therefore slowing down some of the outdoor construction projects such as removing the old art/science module building and redoing of the handicap entrance to the church (the SE Narthex). Please note that these cement project, as well as a new sidewalk for the entrance to the Family Life Center are still in progress, weather permitting. When we see them happening, please remember to stay out of the way of the workers so that they may complete the job quickly. Please use the other temporary entrance to the church, the one by the choir (if you are not able to do steps) or the Father Fickel Center Narthex. (Yes, I named this narthex back in 2010 to honor the 4th pastor with the vision to expand our church and have these safety/hospitality places in 1988.) Thanks for your ongoing tithing that makes these improvement projects possible!
