On November 19th, 19 representatives from Saint Paschal Baylon and Saint Clare traveled to the National Catholic Youth Conference. The National Catholic Youth Conference is a powerful, biennial, three-day experience of prayer, community, and empowerment for Catholic teenagers (of high school age) and their adult chaperones. More than 23,000 young people and their chaperones attended 2013 NCYC in Indianapolis. The 2015 National Catholic Youth Conference was held November 19-21, back in Indianapolis, with the theme “Here I Am Lord/Aquí Estoy Señor.”

WHAT HAPPENS DURING NCYC? The program includes keynote presentations, prayer, workshops, Mass, and opportunities to participate in reconciliation and adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, as well as recreational activities, concerts, and exhibits. A key component of NCYC is the thematic park which is a blend of traditional exhibit booths with interactive areas featuring service projects, games, recreation, live musical performances, arts, and sports. For the last meeting of the liturgical year (and calendar year), Council convened on All Souls Day, Monday, November 2. **Updates on activities:**

- The Director of Advancement position was posted on several internet job sites, generating more resumes from interested persons.
- Ministry heads summarized recent projects at the November 10 Quarterly meeting.
- Various parish ministries will be invited to sponsor coffee and doughnuts after Mass.

Father Lane reported on the recent meeting of the Diocesan pastors with Bishop Lennon. Statistics from a recent CARA study of the diocese noted the dwindling number of priests available for ministry and looked at the effects of changing the retirement age for priests. Concerning Mass attendance, less than 25% of the registered Catholics in the diocese celebrate Sunday Mass. And on a national survey of religious affiliation, 23% of those responding chose "NONE".

NEW PROJECTS: Replacement of the handicapped entranceway is stalled due to cement contractors' lack of interest in bidding on small projects during the construction boom now happening in downtown Cleveland. Installation of the electronic "Bourgeois Bells" has gone forward and they will be heard very soon. The new Suggestion Box yielded seven questions/suggestions; Fr. Lane did write about them in his column. Finally, the Liturgy Committee is preparing a parish survey to be presented later in 2016.
