Feast of the Baptism of the LORD: Each year we end Christmas Time and this part of the liturgical year with this important feast of Christ. We hear the public manifestation of God being pleased with his beloved. It is a chance for us to recall our own baptism when we, too, heard God speak to us during this special rite. Our beloved child of God, called into a special relationship of discipleship. Whether we are homebound, have different abilities, introverted or extroverted, God made us unique and special with a distinct way of living out our relationship of service.

One of the key things I say to our Communion Ministers, who go to share the Body of Christ, is that those who are not physically able to be present at Mass are still present to us and have a special home ministry of prayer. It is so moving to me to visit people in their home or at the hospital who feel that this is their special ministry of their discipleship. During this Feast weekend and our Ministry Fair, I ask that the homebound make their renewed commitment to their baptism and to the discipleship by continuing this important parish ministry – the Community at Prayer. The Community at Prayer ministry also manifests itself here at church with our hours of the rite of exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, when exposed in a monstrance or with the Blessed Sacrament reposed in the tabernacle. Parishioners and non-parishioners come around the clock to pray in vigil with the LORD until He comes again. These are important ministries of our parish and thank you for your continued support and visits to continue this important witness of faith and prayer.
