Despite a number of deferrals, a total of 44 units of blood were collected at this drive, including six double-red cell donations. Our next blood drive has been scheduled for April 3<sup>rd</sup>, but this time it will be with LifeShare Community Blood Services. LifeShare is a non-profit, 501(c)(3) organization which operates in Northeast Ohio. Although much smaller than the American Red Cross, it is a primary blood provider to the Cleveland Clinic and University Hospitals health systems. Of particular interest is LifeShare's school grant program (\$500 for every 25 blood donors), which can be a significant benefit to our school! More information to come.
