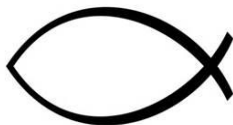

Despite a number of deferrals, a total of 44 units of blood were collected at this drive, including six double-red cell donations. Our next blood drive has been scheduled for April 3rd, but this time it will be with LifeShare Community Blood Services. LifeShare is a non-profit, 501(c)(3) organization which operates in Northeast Ohio. Although much smaller than the American Red Cross, it is a primary blood provider to the Cleveland Clinic and University Hospitals health systems. Of particular interest is LifeShare's school grant program (\$500 for every 25 blood donors), which can be a significant benefit to our school! More information to come.

ADDITIONAL COLLECTION

ADDITIONAL COLLECTION FOR VICTIMS OF SEVERE WEATHER - The diocese has asked us to take a collection for those across the country who have suffered due to the recent severe weather.

Severe weather, in the form of violent storms, tornadoes and floods, impacted states in the South and Midwest regions of our county. Additional major flooding is expected over the next several weeks as rivers and tributaries continue to rise. The Most Revered Joseph E. Kurtz, D.D., President of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops has asked the Bishops of the United States to take up a special collection for the humanitarian and Church needs from these storms.

The funds collected in this one-time special appeal for the 2015-2016 storms and other natural disasters will be used to support the efforts of Catholic Charities USA, the official domestic relief agency of the U.S. Catholic Church, as they and their member agencies respond to immediate emergency needs for such necessities as water, food, shelter, and medical care as well as to the long term need to rebuild and recover after widespread destruction, and to the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops for pastoral and reconstruction needs of the Church.
