FROM THE PASTOR'S PERSPECTIVE



4th Sunday of Easter – World Day for Vocations:

Each year on the 4th Sunday of Easter, “Good Shepherd Sunday,” the universal church celebrates World Day for Vocations. It’s our annual opportunity to promote and preach about vocations to the ordained and consecrated life (sisters, nuns, monks and brothers). As we have done over the last 7 years, we have had a special speaker preach to us about vocations. The last two years, Fr John and I had our mom’s share with your our family vocation stories. This year you are being introduced to the new Vocation Director of the Sisters of Notre Dame, Sister Kelly

Rush. I hope you enjoy listening to her witness; more importantly, we have had only two women become sisters from our parish and four men become priests. In our 63 years, it’s time for us to become more active in promoting and affirming young men and women to religious life and the ordained ministry of our church. Not just this weekend, but also each day – see something? Say something! Thank you for being part of the vocation promotion team!

60th Anniversary of the School Reunion: We had over 100 alumnae return last Saturday for a special celebration – alum from the 1950s thru last year’s graduation. The most students returned – from the class of 1974! I am grateful for the anniversary committee that put on such a wonderful event with a special Mass. We thank you for participating in the process to select the honored graduate – Tim Salcer! We always want to share “good news” about our school to our graduates, so please do not hesitate to drop a line, share a link and help us continue to maintain contact. Our school produces outstanding women and men who serve the community well. Help us share this story!

Preparations for Spring Fling: It’s nice to have the new committee members making meatballs in your kitchen! This is one of the exciting new features of Spring Fling, our parish festival. I hope you have marked your calendar, invited your neighbors and friends, and are planning on attending multiple times Thursday thru Sunday, May 19 – 22. One of the great highlights this year, during our outdoor Mass, is the Blessing of the Bourgeois Bells. We will begin our Sunday Noon Mass in the SSS kitchen parking lot and process to the tent for Mass. Deacon Joe’s family will be here – and they are so honored to be part of our parish festival activities this year; we are honored to enjoy such beautiful bells! In lieu of the 5K run/walk, the Athletic Association will be sponsoring and running a Family Scavenger hunt on Sunday 22 May at 1:15PM. Continued Spiritual Growth: While typing this bulletin, final preparations for the LITE Retreat are occurring. We pray that our Saturday retreat day for adults and teens will continue to be a big blessing. As part of our pastoral plan, we are offering at various times of the year opportunities here at SPB for spiritual growth. Besides our parish mission, we have had special talks on the Year of Mercy. This summer, you may have noticed that we will have our annual Saint Ann Triduum with Jesuit Father Lorn Snow. He is the former pastor of Gesu, back for these

special days, preaching about one of the loves of his life – Good Saint Ann! Having grown up “across the river” from the Saint Ann Shrine in Canada, and the family’s annual pilgrimage to the shrine there, Fr. Snow developed a special devotion to Saint Ann and he will share this with us.
