6th Sunday of Easter Time: Isn't it nice to have someone to stand up for you? Whether it's a buddy in school, a lawyer/advocate, or some other representative, we each know the special relationship when there is someone in our lives who is there for us. Today's Gospel reminds us that the Advocate, the Holy Spirit is always with us to teach us and give peace. It was a promise that Jesus gave, and it is a promise we know we are blessed to keep. The Eucharist is our reminder that this promise and peace are with us!

Come and receive the bread of peace and the wine of joy!

First Communion: While Easter Time is rapidly moving along this year, due to the earlier celebration of the season, we still have our annual first Sunday of May celebration of First Communion. We welcome all the families and visitors who are here to support our young people in this important step in faith. Congratulations First Communicants! We are proud of you and the journey of regularly receiving the LORD. It's a great time for us to remember our own First Communion and faith journey – where we have been, and how we have been led by the Advocate to peace and trust.

Annual May Crowning! This being the 60th anniversary of the school, one of the final events is May Crowning, combined with a special tribute and thank you to our Grandparents and a special Mass this Wednesday. Notice, we have been advertising since January that the Mass time is different for **THIS WEDNESDAY ONLY! It's a 9:30 a.m.**

REMINDER: Ascension Sunday! We do not know the actual day that Jesus ascended to heaven. Sorry to break or burst a bubble! Scripture lists a few days as possibilities. For two decades now, our part of the country celebrates this solemnity on a Sunday, so do not get confused by your liturgical calendar this week. While we would love to have you every Thursday for weekday Mass, this Thursday the readings are from the 6th week of Easter. **NEXT SUNDAY** we celebrate Ascension.

Do Join Us! We do special things for Lent; why not for Easter Time? Join us for weekday Masses, especially the 9 a.m. each weekday, but also there is also the Shrine Mass at 11:30 and extra bonus Masses on Monday (12:15 p.m.), Tuesday (6:30 a.m.) and Wednesday (12:15 p.m.).

Special Outdoor Mass During Spring Fling: One of our annual special traditions is the Mass under the big tent for Spring Fling, our parish festival. This year, our very own "Light of Two Moons" will be our musicians; sorry, no polkas! Extra special this year is that Deacon Joe Bourgeois' family will be here for the blessing of the Bourgeois Bells. This special gift from the Bourgeois family in memory of Fr. Louis Bourgeois, a priest of the archdiocese of Boston, brother of our own Deacon Joe, will take place before the Mass in the tent.

We will begin the Mass at the SSS Kitchen Parking Lot – there is a special blessing of the bells ritual in the *Book of Blessings*. Then, we will process singing the opening song to the tent. So gather first at the parking lot, for those who are able to walk/process. This will be Sunday, May 22 at the Noon Mass.

Prayers for 2nd Graders: Congratulations to our 2nd graders who will make their First Holy Communion this weekend! Please pray for them as they take this step closer to Jesus and receive Eucharist for the first time.

Registration: Registration is now underway for the 2016-2017 PSR school year. Forms were sent home with current students in early April.
