The woman from the Food Bank who had called on Monday came to see me Tuesday to thank us for our help with the mom and baby. She also just happened to have three large boxes of toilet paper to give to us, just what we needed for some of the people we help. I believe that God will always give us what we need especially if we are faithful to His people in need. As I have said before, you never know when God will knock on our door and we should always be there to answer His call. God bless all of you.

PSR REGISTRATION:

Forms are available from the Parish Office and on psr.saintpaschal.com. To avoid a late fee, please register as soon as possible. Early tuition rates for this year are \$85 for 1 child, \$155 for 2 children, and \$230 for 3 or more children.

Scholarships are available. Additionally, our registration form serves as the emergency medical form as well as the media release form for your convenience.
