STEWARDSHIP REPORT

Grateful for Endowment Donations: George Cicero Foundation made a gift to the Endowment Fund of \$2,793.10. So many years a generous and faithful parishioner – a wonderful tribute and legacy from his will to the school.

Special Reimbursement: Due to the members of the parish who still have been paying their pledges to the Diocesan Capital Campaign, we received a **\$6,188 Quarterly Distribution check from Rooted in Faith**. Thank you for fulfilling your commitment – and supporting our maintenance funds.

LOVE POWERS OUR MISSION – Catholic Charities Annual Appeal

FROM THE DIOCESE: Because of you ... **nearly \$700,000 has been pledged through the May Parish Appeal** for the benefit of the children and young adults at Rosemary. Thank you! We could not have done it without your support and leadership.

When we asked you to participate in this second appeal, we had no idea the impact it would have on Rosemary’s “Homes for Our Future” project. We have now exceeded last year’s May appeal by close to \$100,000. When you add the \$100,000 matching grant, we have raised nearly \$200,000 more than last year.

Parishioners across the diocese found it in their hearts to give to the Annual Appeal. **797 gave for the first time, 3,526 gave an additional gift and 2,033 previous donors made their first gift this year.** These new donors are especially critical to the long-term impact of the Appeal.

I am happy to share with you the results at St. Paschal Baylon parish:
