FROM THE PASTOR'S PERSPECTIVE



Second Sunday of Lent: Each year we climb the mountain with the disciples to the Gospel of the Transfiguration on this second Sunday of Lent. Have you ever noticed someone with “the glow?” That special look? They may have just given birth to a new baby. They may have just passed the bar. They may have gotten keys to the car. It’s a special moment when you realize you are not the same and you are at a new level of your life. To me, this is what the Transfiguration was for Jesus – and for us. We all get to a point where we know who we are and what is now expected of us. It can be

hopeful or we may be scared silly. In any event, it’s a change and a new challenge all in the same proud moment. May we remember the glow we have experienced and perhaps experience again and again as we realize more our responsibility as followers of Jesus Christ and how we are called to live very seriously our duty as disciples.

Pastor Swap: This weekend while you are enjoying the mission with Fr. Tom Dragga, I’m covering for him at his parish, the Church of the Resurrection, Solon, Ohio. With the priest shortage, we have to help one another out and pray for other men to hear the call to serve the LORD – and glow!

Community at Prayer News: Many of our pray-ers have gone to God over the years, a few have moved to other places. We have made numerous calls and pleas for more members to make a commitment for certain hours of the week to be covered to have continuous prayer in the setting of exposition of the Blessed Sacrament. However, we are now at a point where, after consultation with the Liturgy Commission and Dick Kramer, chair of the ministry, we are making a few decisions: we will no longer have exposition of the Blessed Sacrament on Fridays and Saturdays. Those who did have an hour on Friday are welcome to still come to pray – for Christ is always present. However, we will not have exposition, which is using a monstrance with the Blessed Sacrament, for there are so many times on Friday and Saturday when the monstrance and tabernacle are being left there and unlocked and this is not allowed by church law. Exposition is a formal liturgical rite of the church; we are not allowed to just expose for a moment here and there. With so few on Friday and Saturday, we are asking those members of the Community at Prayer to attend to hours during the week that need coverage. Dick will be providing a new list for us at the table next to the chapel.

Thank you for understanding. We are discerning the future of this ministry and hope more people will continue to join in this powerful ministry of prayer. As usual, the church is open for prayer all the time, and one may always “make a visit.” This is highly encouraged and one may pray in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament without exposition.

Special Week Ahead! Our parish mission continues Monday and Tuesday nights. Additionally, with Saint Patrick Day being on a Friday this year, diocesan administrator, Bishop Daniel Thomas has dispensed us from the Friday fast from meat. We may have our corned beef this year and eat other meats, too this Friday in honor of this great saint! We are asked to do another act of penance if we do eat meat on Friday.

- Wednesday is the special night of celebration of the Sacrament of Reconciliation in every parish in the diocese. You are welcome to come between 5:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m. to celebrate the sacrament of penance – another great thing to do during Lent.
- Next Monday, due to March 19 being a Sunday, we will celebrate the solemnity of Saint Joseph. Our school loves Saint Joseph and will also attend the 9:00 a.m. Mass Monday morning.
- Additionally, I'll be giving the parish mission at Saint Ambrose, Brunswick from March 18 – 22, so please pray for this parish and me as we grow together in faith.
