FROM THE PASTOR'S PERSPECTIVE



Easter Sunday Joy – Week 6: "If you love me, you will keep my commandments." Our Gospel today begins with this special line. For most of us we probably say to ourselves, "LORD I love you, you know how much I love you --- sorry for breaking a few!" The most important command is "loving." Loving as God loves is the challenge and is what we CAN do when we trust the Holy Spirit to help us take over our lives and especially love the most difficult. Let us pray together to "let go" of that which keeps us from loving and be in that special communion of love with God.

<u>Ascension:</u> Don't be confused by the calendar you received from the church or

others- we still, as we have for almost 25 years, keep Sunday – NEXT SUNDAY as the day we celebrate the Ascension of the LORD on Sunday, May 28. Thursday, May 25 is a weekday of Easter.

Education Night: Thursday, June 1 – 7:00 – 8:30 p.m. Some of our parishioners have come together to reform our Social Action Commission. One of the goals of the pastoral plan and this new commission is to have education nights to better inform us on the Catholic social teachings. Join us for the first education night Thursday, June 1, when we feature Stacy Dever from the Diocese of Cleveland's Office of Migration and Refugee Services. Our goal is to better understand the terms that are tossed around so loosely that they become negative and impact human beings lives. Let us be open to growing and understanding.

After a consultation with the Liturgy Commission and the Quarterly (our regular leaders meeting), we are updating and creating a more consistent Weekday Mass schedule. <u>In case you missed the news:</u> So much happened at our regular parish leaders meeting – the Quarterly. Last week I had the complete notes, taken by Kathy Pohlhammer, our Communication Director. Here is a summary, especially about Saint Paschal Lane – and the latest news about this.

Capital Campaign Update

- Fr. Lane explained that the project to raise funds for a capital campaign would be put on hold, pending the appointment of a new bishop for our diocese.
- Barb DiTurno explained that while we wait; there is still a great deal of prep work, i.e. case statement, timeline, gift tables, logo and committees, etc. to be accomplished.

Spring Fling

We are so grateful to Bob Mastrangelo and the festival committee. They work hard all year to insure such a beautiful event. Enjoy the wonderful new program booklet--- see how many wonderful people sponsored Spring Fling and helped us generate 18K in sponsorship revenue.

Saint Paschal Lane Repair/Replace Discussion & Consultation

O Saint Paschal Lane is being replaced! The Quarterly unanimously voted to take out a loan to raise the funds. We have narrowed a bid and are finalizing the details with a company and the diocese facilities management

office. We are also finalizing the loan payments and rolling this in to our current loan. Our current loan for the school, gym and Father O'Brien Hall roofs is now at \$160,000. A quick fundraiser and letter-writing campaign will take place soon. I am hoping we can count on your support with a summer donation to the SPL repair. We are always looking for a sponsor to name the SPLane. Let us know if you and/or your business is interested in "naming rights."

Storage Space/Eymard Kitchen

- Fr. Lane invited attendees to become part of a new Kitchen Storage Sub-Committee to assess storage needs and update the design in the Eymard kitchen. He also shared that the Helping Hands Ministry is donating \$3,000 to purchase and install an "instant hot" water heater.
- Ministries were asked to tag any items in the Eymard kitchen and complete some "spring cleaning" in the area and in Fr. O'Brien Hall. It was explained that items in the parish closet are available for ministry use. Groups who need access to the closet will be given a key. If inventory is low or if a larger quantity of an item is needed, ministries are asked to alert Michelle Mazza, Business Manager
- Fr. Lane requested volunteers for this committee and will meet in to review, plan and improve. (The last time we did a review like this was in the fall of 2009.)
