FROM THE PASTOR'S PERSPECTIVE

Due to the holiday schedule, this bulletin was compiled on August 24



23rd Sunday in ordinary time: The principle of subsidiarity: that's what our Gospel is about today. It's about talking with our brother or sister (or both) and not bringing "business" to others without first having the courtesy, the Christian duty, as Christ says, to talk and listen FIRST with him/her/them.

What have I learned over time? The grace that comes from sharing and discussing FIRST with a person. So why don't we all trust in the grace more often? Why do we make it harder than it has to be? That's why we have the Eucharist – to keep practicing the perfection of grace-filled living, working and being together around this table until we are ready for the banquet table of heaven. Let's keep practicing! Allow the grace and time to work, first by listening, then respectfully dialoging and sharing. Let's trust one another! It's an art – that really takes a lifetime to practice.

Update on our strategic planning process: I am so grateful to a dedicated group of twenty who have met mostly every week of the summer to put together a strategic planning process for us. Let's recall our history: Last year at our September 2013 Leadership Day, a goal developed to have a 5-year plan. The Pastoral Council discerned the prospect of this goal and the many others and implemented a process by which we contacted a chair and subcommittee, made of members of each of the main parish organizations that wished to send a representative. At the same time, Sharon Martin became the chair of the committee and contacted Case Western Reserve University Weatherhead School of Business and two students to assist in gathering data for the parish, about the parish and thru the eyes of "visitors." They interviewed many of our parishioners, and then members of our Strategic Planning Committee also interviewed parishioners to find out, "What are the best things about SPB?" And, "Where do we want to grow in the future?" We took your comments and have been formulating them into strategies. We are almost done – but working on how the goals will be implemented, how they will be measured and who will be responsible. Thank you for your continued prayers as we look to wrapping up this process by November. As always, keep your eyes geared to the bulletin and our updated website for current information.

Website: Have you seen our website lately? Thanks to our Development Team and our volunteers, it has become a better tool for communication. Please visit it often, see what's there, let us know what is not and how we can keep improving. It's a work in progress and grows with us! As you may have heard, the diocesan newspaper will be coming to an end in 2015, it will become more important than ever to stay connected through electronic and social media; continue to help us serve you through this venue.
