## FROM THE PASTOR'S PERSPECTIVE



### 20<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time & The Assumption:

This is one of those weekends where the liturgical calendar and rules remind us of the mysteries of celebrating the Holy Family – and our family! As we recall, the LORD'S Day begins at 4:00 p.m. Saturday (since the calendar of the church was revised in 1969). Therefore, when another solemnity, like the LORD'S Day, begins (think of what we do for Christmas!), the same principle works. That's why

this year the Assumption begins as it does, 4:00 p.m. Sunday, August 14 with a special vigil – and vigil readings and prayers. A vigil means we keep watch, we prepare and we anticipate. A few years back, in order to not have the worry of missing a solemnity, or holy day of obligation, the bishops of our country relaxed the obligation from a few of these special “holy days” throughout the year (January 1, August 15 & November 1). They still are “holy days,” just without the obligation to attend Mass. This year, with Assumption falling as it does on a Monday, that obligation is relaxed, that is, there is none. However, as you know, we love our Blessed Mother in this parish – we come out to celebrate the witness and gift she is to the church and us. So see you tonight (Sunday at 7:00 p.m.) or tomorrow at one of our usual holy day Masses. What I love the most about this solemnity? How you all belt out the Marian songs! Keep up that great music to God, especially at communion time!

**New Group:** Many of you are aware that we have a process we have for initiating a new parish group or organization in our parish. First a parishioner (or in this case and outside organization) approaches the pastor. Then I bring it to the Pastoral Staff and Pastoral Council for discussion. That's what's happening with the “Legion of Mary,” an international group with devotion to the Blessed Mother. After our discussions “in house,” we made an appeal here in the bulletin – and several parishioners expressed interest. Tomorrow, Monday, August 15 at 6:00 p.m. we will have our first organizational meeting.

**Retreat Weekend for Couples:** Marriage is a blessing, a joy, and challenging at times! That's what I've been told and, truth be told, I've witnessed over the years with couples. To support couples and give them an opportunity for a getaway retreat weekend, the church offers a ministry called “Marriage Encounter.” Our Pastoral Plan (and we are in the midst of year two) suggested having spiritual opportunities for couples, especially newly married or younger couples, to support their vocation of marriage. Please pray on this – please take the time to support your marriage, and ask grandma and grandpa, or an aunt, uncle or godparent to be available to “watch” the kids the weekend of **October 8 – 9**, to be held at SPB.

## STEWARDSHIP REPORT

### **Campaign for Human Development:**

As part of our Pastoral Plan, we inform you about the transparency of our collections, especially our second collections. Each year in November, a special collection is given to provide grants for local and national organizations that, from the grassroots and local agencies, assist those who are trying to address the areas of poverty in our community, raising people up to bring hope and a better way of life. Two weeks ago, we received word of the following, two National Grants, totaling \$135,000 have been awarded in our diocese and with connections to our parish:

- **Esperanza Threads** - *Industrial Sewing Training Program and Apprenticeships* -CCHD funds will be used to further the expansion of the apprenticeship program, and also to fairly pay the trainers of the Basic Industrial Sewing Training Program.
- **EDWINS Leadership & Restaurant Institute** - *Culinary Training Program* -EDWINS will use CCHD funds to expand the culinary training program to five other prisons in Ohio, which is being used currently and successfully at Grafton Correctional Institution
- Local Grants totaling more than \$15,000 have been awarded for projects in the areas of Youth and Young Adult and Community Grants.
  - **Catholic Schools for Peace & Justice** -*Economic Realities of Immigration, Refugees & Labor Trafficking, to be the focus of the 2017 Summer Summit.*
  - **Youth & Young Adult Ministry Office** -*Cleveland Catholic Youth Conference: Funding presenters for the workshop entitled, “Ethic and Racial Justice in Cleveland”.*
  - **Westlake Area Youth Group of Saints Ladislav & Bernadette** -*Days of Martha & Mary: Summer Youth Immersion & Mission Trip*
  - **Our Lady of the Lake** - *Micro-Lending Project to help low-income entrepreneurs launch small businesses.*

- **South Street Ministries** - 2016 Strategic Planning to help the center plan for future direction and impact in the South-Akron community.

The course study on Saint Peter Julian Eymard faith formation program resumes after two months off on Wednesday, August 17.
