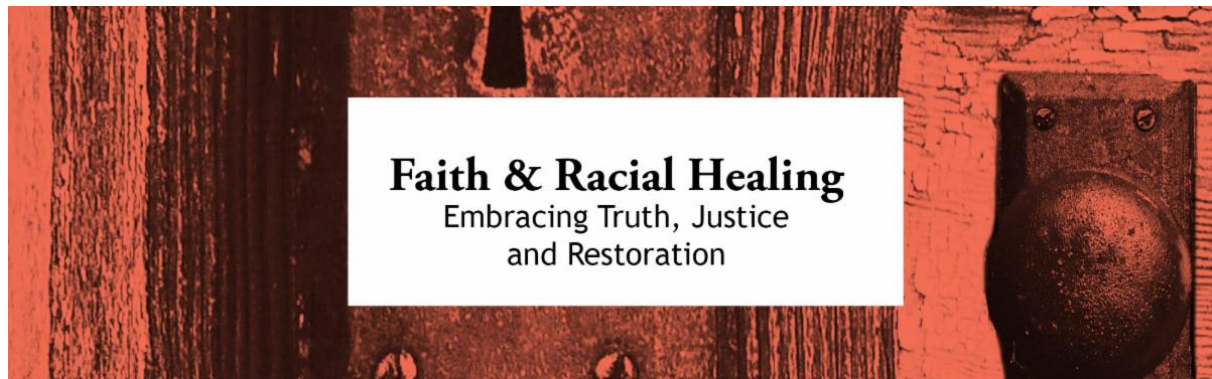


**"Faith and Racial Healing" Study Group Members Sought for JustFaith Eight-Week Parish Small Group Process- Contact Us Soon!**
